approach to ensure that the long-promised, but never delivered, Hengrove Leisure Park and South Bristol Hospital are finally delivered.

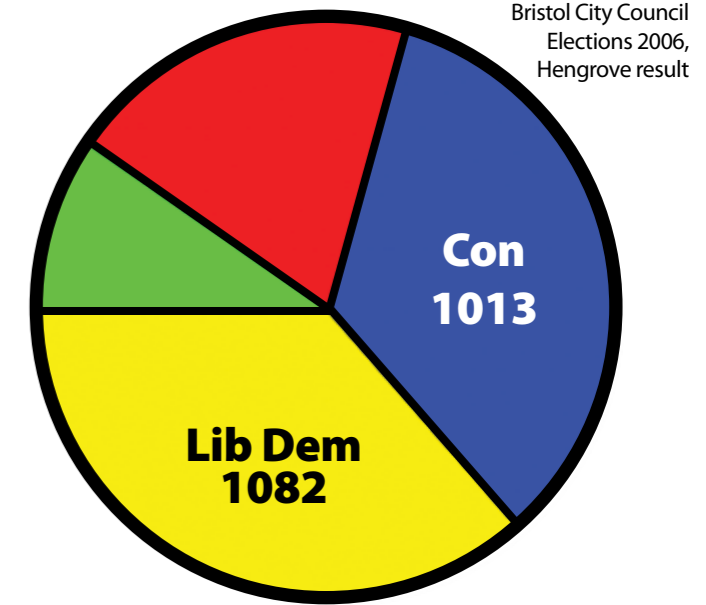
For too long South Bristol has been promised improvements. It is now your chance to vote positively to ensure they are delivered.
